### Academy News

#### Ofsted Inspection

Several parents have asked when the Ofsted report will be published. Following inspection, a number of quality assurance processes have to take place and we anticipate being able to share the report with you in two or three weeks.

#### Athletics Competitions

This week 36 children from across Key Stage 2 took part in two athletics competitions through the Bishop Challoner Sports Partnership. The attitude and resilience of each child taking part was exceptional and we are very proud of everyone who represented the school. In the Year 3 & 4 competition, we finished 5th out of 13 schools and in the Year 5 & 6 competition, we finished 8th out of 15 schools. . Well done everyone!

#### 'Build and Burn' Workshop

Lots of family members came into school to join in with the Key Stage 1 'Brilliant Beginning' for our new topic *The Great Fire of London*. We used wood and straw to replicate the building materials used in 1666 and then set the houses up in two different ways - close together and spaced apart - before burning them! This experiment helped us to find out which layout made the fire spread more quickly.
