Year 6 SATs Results 2019

This letter provides the interim 2019 key stage 2 national attainment figures and the results achieved by the children of Moor Green.

What does attainment look like nationally?

65% of children in England reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined. To reach the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, a child must achieve a scaled score of **100 or more** in reading and maths tests and a teacher assessment outcome of 'reaching the expected standard' in writing. Scaled scores range from 80-120 with 100 being the expected standard. Children have to achieve a scaled score of **110 or more** to achieve the higher standard (greater depth). 2019 national figures for the higher standard have not been released yet.

What does attainment look like at Moor Green Primary Academy?

79% of children in Moor Green reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths compared with **65%** nationally.

Reading: 81% of children reached the expected standard compared with **73%** nationally.

Writing: 85% of children reached the expected standard compared with **78%** nationally.

Maths: 83% of children reached the expected standard compared with **79%** nationally.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS): 83% of children reached the expected standard compared with **78%** nationally.

In reading, maths and GPS, the **higher standard** percentages below are based on children achieving a scaled score of 110 or more. In writing, they are based on teachers' assessment of a child achieving the greater depth standard. They are compared with 2018 national figures because 2019 figures are not available yet.

38% of children achieved the higher standard in **reading** (2018 national av. was **26%**)

31% of children achieved the greater depth standard in **writing** (2018 national av. was **20%**)

25% of children achieved the higher standard in **maths** (2018 national av. was **24%**)

52% of children achieved the higher standard in **grammar, punctuation and spelling** (2018 national av. was **34%**)

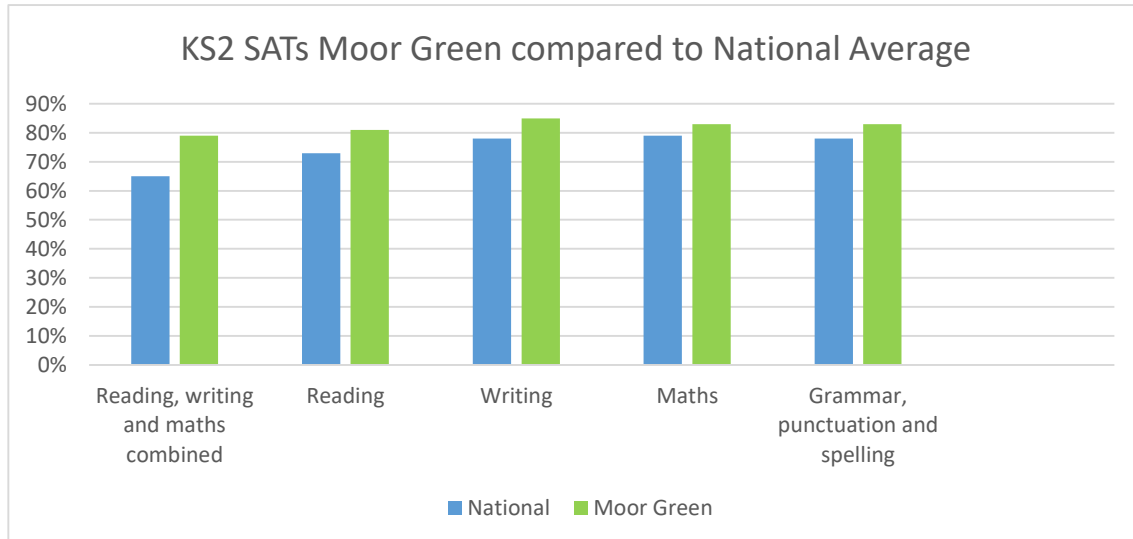
