This booklet will explain what your child will be learning over the coming weeks and how you can support their progress at home. We are really looking forward to working with you this year.





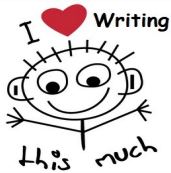
Maths

Writing

This half-term we will be learning about labels and captions. We shall be focusing on full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We will be introducing conjunctions, nouns, verbs and adjectives. To help your child at home please make sure you read a range of texts to them regularly and ask them to identify word types.



Reading
