# ***Ancient Greece***

Our topic this term is **Ancient Greece**.

This booklet will explain what we will be learning over the coming weeks and how you can support your child's progress at home.

### Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on Number and Place Value. To help your child at home, you could ask them to read and order 4 digit numbers and help them with their homework.

To support your child further, please use Times Table Rockstars at home. Every child will have a username and password.



### Writing

This half-term we will be focussing on Explaining and Describing.

To help your child at home, please help them practice their spellings.



### Reading

Children must bring their reading book to school every Wednesday if they have one to change.

Please encourage your child to read at home.

Regular reading is vital to a child becoming a confident writer.



### Grammar and Punctuation

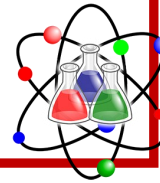
This term, we will be focusing on writing sentences that use fronted adverbials. We will also be looking at vocabulary choices within writing and explaining why these are effective in a particular piece of writing.



### Science

In science, we will be learning about sound and hearing.

We will then go on to investigate states of matter. Children will explore materials and look at the properties of solids, liquids and gasses and observe that materials can change state.



### Religious Education

In RE, we will be learning about inspirational people across a range of religions to develop our understanding of others and their beliefs.



### Geography

In geography, we will be investigating places. We will name and locate countries and cities in Europe and make comparisons between the UK and Greece.



### Art and Design

During art sessions, we will be designing and creating a pot inspired by our topic of Ancient Greece.



This year, all topics will have a Brilliant Beginning and a Fabulous Finish.
