The best way to save a file is using your name e.g. Your name—Spreadsheet.


There are lots of different ways of presenting data, but Excel is often the most effective.

Collecting Data


1. Input the data into the cells and highlight it.




2. Click Insert on the toolbar and then select the bar chart.
