# Moor Green's 2024 Statutory Assessment Results Compared to National Benchmarks

# End of EYFS Results - The % of children reaching a Good Level of Development

	Moor Green	National
2022	80%	65%
2023	81%	65%
2024	80%	68%

- 71% of boys achieved a GLD vs. 61% nationally.
- 89% of girls achieved a GLD vs. 75% nationally.
- 71% of disadvantaged pupils achieved a GLD vs. 70% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national figure was 52%).

# Year 1 Phonic Screening Check – an assessment of children's phonic ability

	Moor Green	National
2022	85%	75%
2023	88%	79%
2024	93%	80%

- 96% of boys passed the phonics screening check vs.77% nationally.
- 91% of girls passed the phonics screening check vs. 84% nationally.
- 88% of disadvantaged pupils passed the phonics screening check vs. 84% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national figure was 69%).

**Year 2 Cumulative Phonics:** 98% vs. 89%\* nationally (\*2023 figure).

**Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check:** 25 out of 25: 47% vs. 29%\* nationally (\*2023 figure) 21 to 25 marks: 75% vs. 64% nationally

#### Reading:

- 87% of boys achieved the expected standard vs. 71% nationally.
- 87% of girls achieved the expected standard vs. 78% nationally.
- 75% of disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard vs. 79% of nondisadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 63%)
- 24% of boys achieved greater depth vs. 25% nationally.
- 22% of girls achieved greater depth vs. 32% nationally.
- 15% of disadvantaged pupils achieved greater depth vs. 33% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 18%)

#### Writing:

- 89% of boys achieved the expected standard vs. 65% nationally.
- 87% of girls achieved the expected standard vs. 78% nationally.
- 70% of disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard vs. 77% of nondisadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 59%)
- 19% of boys achieved greater depth vs. 10% nationally.
- 30% of girls achieved greater depth vs. 16% nationally.
- 5% of disadvantaged pupils achieved greater depth vs. 16% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 6%)

#### Maths:

- 87% of boys achieved the expected standard vs. 74% nationally.
- 87% of girls achieved the expected standard vs. 72% nationally.
- 65% of disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard vs. 79% of nondisadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 59%)
- 46% of boys achieved greater depth vs. 26% nationally.
- 30% of girls achieved greater depth vs. 21% nationally.
- 15% of disadvantaged pupils achieved greater depth vs. 29% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 13%)



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#### Combined:

- 84% of boys achieved the expected standard vs. 57% nationally.
- 83% of girls achieved the expected standard vs. 64% nationally.
- 65% of disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard vs. 67% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 46%)
- 14% of boys achieved greater depth vs. 6% nationally.
- 9% of girls achieved greater depth vs. 9% nationally.
- 0% of disadvantaged pupils achieved greater depth vs. 10% of non-disadvantaged pupils nationally. (Disadvantaged national was 3%)
