Welcome back!

We hope you enjoyed the break and are looking forward to an exciting term ahead. Our topic this term is

Explorers!

This booklet will explain what your child will be learning over the coming weeks and how you can support their progress at home.

Maths

In maths, we shall be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and ordering numbers to 20. We will be using 'greater' and 'lesser' in our maths vocabulary. We will also be learning to add and subtract within 20 using the part-whole model.



RE

In RE, we will be looking at the importance of things in our own lives and comparing them to different religious beliefs. We will be learning to relate our experiences to figures from a range of religions.

Science

In science lessons, we will be learning about plants. We shall be looking at trees and what makes them different, as well as parts of a flower.



History

In history, we will be finding out about Scott of the Antarctic and learning about his expedition.



Writing

Grammar and Punctuation

This half-term we will be focusing on punctuation and different types of sentences and words.

You could help your child by talking about punctuation they find in their reading book, such as full stops and question marks.

Encourage them to say and write questions about a topic which interests them.



Art and Design Technology

In DT, we will be designing a shelter/tent for Scott to stay in.

In Art, we will be using clay to make a flower tiles and complete observational drawings of flowers.



Reading

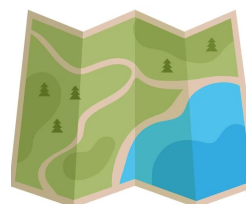
Reading books will be changed once a week and we will write comments about how well your child is reading in school.
