This term, we will be focusing on improving and extending our sentences. We will also be looking at various types of punctuation within writing and understanding why these are essential in a piece of writing.

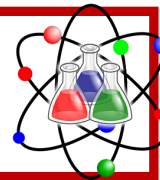


### History
